- 2. Discussion Items / Public Input:** Nothing added
- 3. Principal Update:**
 - a. Approved additional payment for Paras for the 2025-26 school year; this had been agreed upon by last year's SAC committee.

- 4. Review changes affecting 26-27 budget (Clint)**
 - a. The District's projections of students for the 26-27 school year show lower enrollment at 307 students.
 - b. The SAC must solve for having approximately \$185,000 to work with next year
 - c. The District will no longer having the Math Fellows program in DPS
 - d. Clint will not renew the contract for Lexia reading program for next year
- 5. Budget priorities agreed upon by the SAC**
 - a. Student Facing positions
 - b. Tier 2 programming (academic interventions, Bilingual mental health support)



6. Possible scenarios presented and discussed

- a. Seven scenarios were presented (submitted by Clint and Anonymous SAC members). These seven scenarios were narrowed down to four.
- b. Motion was made by Aloma to proceed with scenario #7, Seconded by Courtney. There was consensus within the SAC members present.
- c. Clint had additional conversations and made adjustments to the final budget prior to submitting the 26-27 budget to the district.

 - i. Dean of Culture
 - ii. .5 FTE Social Worker
 - iii. Student, Parent, Family and Community Liaison
- b. New Hire Positions:
 - i. Restorative Justice
 - ii. .5 FTE Bilingual Counselor
- c. SAC also came to consensus that we should keep the Centus counselor for next year because of the cost value.
