1. Call to order and welcome (5)

2. Discussion Items / Public Input

3. Principal Update(s)

a. Enrollment:

- Projected at 339 (with ECE 375) vs. Actual 327 (with ECE 363) [-12 students]
- Awaiting October Count for any new students to our school/district.
- Enrollment on average (past 5 years) of 350 students w/ FRL = around 77%

b. Budget:

- Initial Amount over Cap: \$108,980
- We have \$350k in reserve
- Enrollment Exception: \$80,220
- Final amount Over Cap: \$28,760

(Clint requested funds to cover Lexia Reading program)

c. School SPF:

- Past 3 years (2022-2024) Montclair was Green (Performance Plan)
- Prior years (2018 & 2019) Montclair was Yellow (Improvement plan)
- This year (2025) Montclair received 41.1% points rated as Orange (Priority Improvement). This is a decrease of 17.8%. However the school is just shy of being Yellow. The CDE is reviewing our Early Literacy data to determine if the rating can be revised.

d. School Targets - Meet or Exceed (All Students):

- 24-25 CMAS Science results = 22% / 25-26 Goal = 23%
- 24-25 CMAS Math results = 17% / 25-26 Goal = 41%
- 24-25 CMAS ELA results = 23.2% / 25-26 Goal = 48%
- 24-25 Early Literacy K-3 results = 68% / 25-26 Goal = 70%
- 24-25 Early Literacy K-3 Sig. Below Grade Level = 36% / 25-26 Goal = 35%
- 24-25 Chronically Absent = 53% (have missed 18 days or more) / Goal = 35%

e. UIP / Three Major Improvement Strategies

- Data Driven Instruction (focus on Tier One in all systems)
- Professional Learning Communities (data)
- Attendance Intervention

(Clint would like to bring data to SAC for the members to review and ask questions.)

f. Enrichment

- NEW - Soccer & Flag football to be offered after school
- CHIC (Collaborative Healing In Communities) - cost \$9,000
 - Social Emotional and Cultural Education Program
 - They come 2x per month for the year
 - Serves 25-30 girls
 - BEST data is one way to select students along with teachers nominations).
 - Aloma motions to keep CHIC at school (Ash Seconded).
- Girls on the Run
- Clint would like Guest Speakers and Field Trips to align with CARES

g. Questions

- **Attendance Question:** There was a clarification regarding families that take vacations outside of school breaks. These days missed are still considered as "chronically absent". Unfortunately the district does not distinguish between students that are very sick versus families on vacation or students that don't come to school. Minutes tardy are also added up by the district which can add up to a day absent.
- **Enrichment Question:** Could we bring back Explorations? Aloma asked if classified staff can be a part and support groups. Clint will send out a survey to the staff for feedback regarding their interest in bringing back Explorations.
